LESSON 2

TITLE: What Would You Do If?

PURPOSE: To recognize the possibility that anyone can be a bully, a victim or a bystander.

OBJECTIVES: The student will be able to:

- focus on improving self awareness in bullying situations
- discriminate between the roles of bully, victim and bystander.

INSTRUCTIONAL TIME: 45 Minutes

PREPARATION/INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS:

- dry erase board and markers
- copies of handout 6-2 (one per student)
- pen

SPRINGBOARD ACTIVITY:

- 1) Discuss the word *roles*. A *role* is the part someone plays in a given setting or situation. Provide the following examples:
 - a) Whenever anyone in the family is sick, mother always takes care of them. Mother is a caregiver.
 - b) Every time someone misbehaves at camp, they are sent to the Camp Leader. Our Camp Leader is the disciplinarian of the staff.

- c) Melissa's role in our family is that of a cheerleader. She always wants to make sure that everyone is happy.

ACTIVITY:

1) Have the students complete handout 6-2: What Would You Do If? Discuss each of the scenarios. Have the students share what he/she would do in the given scenario.

ASSESSMENT: Teacher observation, class participation and completion of activity.

FOLLOW-UP ACTIVITY: Divide the class into small cooperative groups of 3 students. Each group is to come up with a scenario in which there is a bully, a victim and a bystander. Give each group 3 minutes to role play the scenario in front of the class. Ask students to verbally respond to the following questions:

- 1) Who is the bully, the victim and the bystander?
- 2) What is the presenting issue?
- 3) What can each of the characters do to help solve the problem?



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What Would You Do If?

After each scenario, say whether the role described is that of a bully, victim, or a bystander. In the line provided, share what you would do in the given scenario.
