### LESSON 2

**TITLE:** What Do We Know About Bullies?

**PURPOSE:** To fully understand the role of bully, victim and bystander and how those roles influence the outcome of a conflict.

**OBJECTIVES:** The student will be able to:

- identify their role in a conflict.
- choose from a variety of strategies to prevent conflict.

**INSTRUCTIONAL TIME:** 50 Minutes

**PREPARATION/INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS:**

- dry erase board and markers
- copies of Handout 7-1 (one per student)

**SPRINGBOARD ACTIVITY:**

- 1) Have students complete handout 7-1: KWL Chart – Understanding Roles in Conflict
- 2) Prior to the lesson, review the K (What you know...) and W (What you want to know...) points.

**ACTIVITY:** Have students visit [www.stopbullying.gov](http://www.stopbullying.gov) to research the elements of their “W” column.

**ASSESSMENT:** Teacher observation, class participation and completion of activity.

**FOLLOW-UP ACTIVITY:** Review the last element of the KWL chart. Have students state what they learned. Have students go back to the W column and research some of the points they would like to learn more about.
