LESSON 1

TITLE: Let's Be Kind to One Another

PURPOSE: To increase awareness about ways to be kind to one another.

OBJECTIVES: The student will be able to:

- identify acts of kindness.
- distinguish between an act of kindness and an unkind act.

INSTRUCTIONAL TIME: 20 Minutes

PREPARATION/INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS:

- Book: Let's Be Kind by P.K. Hallinan or any book on kindness (see Handout PK-1 for other books on kindness)
- dry erase board and markers
- white sheet of paper
- pencils
- crayons

SPRINGBOARD ACTIVITY: Ask students to define the words *kind* and *unkind*. Solicit examples of each of the words. List responses on the board.

ACTIVITY:

1. Read and discuss the book: Let's Be Kind by P.K. Hallinan to the class.

2. Read each sentence below. After each sentence, ask the students if the sentence is an example of a kind act or an unkind act.
 - a. Maria shows Michelle where the crayons are in class.
 - b. Sue laughed when Tom fell on the floor.
 - c. Mary hugged Elizabeth when she started crying.
 - d. Alex's friend, Michael gave him a snack because Alex forgot his lunch.
 - e. Larry helped his teacher clean the board.

ASSESSMENT: Teacher observation, class participation and completion of follow up activity.

FOLLOW-UP ACTIVITY: Have the students draw a picture of a kind act he/she performed. As the students are drawing their picture, go around to each student and ask him/her to tell you about their picture. Place a title at the top of the page that tells about the student's drawing. Illustrations may be sent home for students to share with their parent/guardian.
